
Biblical Truth

Writing from prison, Paul says in **2 Timothy 3:16-17** *"All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."*

What makes the Bible so Trustworthy?

- No other book in history has been subjected to the study and scrutiny that the Bible has endured. Many who set out to destroy the Bible became Christians.
- The Bible is the most widely distributed book in the world. It was written by more than 40 diverse authors from 3 continents, in 3 different languages over a period of about 1500 years. The Bible is remarkable in the consistency of its content, the accuracy of its prophesy, and the timelessness of its message.
- The book of Genesis explains how our earth, universe, and life came into existence. The Bible reveals: a) God exists, b) What He is like, and c) What His will is for our lives.
- Contrary to popular belief, the Genesis account is supported by the observable evidence throughout the all fields of science.

- The historical accuracy of biblical archaeology has long been established.
- Jewish translators were meticulous in their biblical translation. Discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls between 1947-56 confirmed the Bible's accuracy over time, as do other ancient texts.
- One after another, Bible prophesies have or are being fulfilled. The Old Testament predicted many events in history that were fulfilled in the New Testament.
- The Bible is filled with revelations in the fields of astronomy, medicine, biology, anatomy and physics, that were not discovered by scientists until centuries later. For instance, before telescopes when only a few thousand stars were visible in the night sky, the Bible compared the stars to grains of sand Jeremiah 33:22. The Bible claimed each star was unique Corinthians 15:41. Today that seemingly ridiculous claim is a scientific fact.
