The Big Deception

The theory of evolution is founded on the belief that God is not necessary in the equation of life. Nothing is further from the truth.

Evolution Theory is not a Fact of Science

Claims about evolutionary origins are not based on empirical scientific research. These claims deny the

possibility that God created the universe and the world around us. The evolution theory can't explain where the matter and energy came from to fuel a big bang. Nor can it account for the creation of life from non-life. The best they can do is claim that all life forms ascended from lower forms of life; yet, they offer no credible explanation for the complexity of even the lowest form of life. In addition, they do so by ignoring the lack of fossil evidence to support their claim.
