Why American Churches Need Apologetic Ministries

Europe - Under 10% regularly practice Christianity.
United States - 85% of Christian churches are in decline, 10% are flat and only 5% are growing.
Christian students - More than 50% stop following their faith before they complete their public education.
Christian beliefs - 2/3 of Christians under 65 & 1/3 over 65 attending church accept evolution rather than the foundational biblical Genesis account of creation.
Absolute Truth - Less than 10% of youth believe this.
Evolution - The sole undisputed faith based religion in our schools is evolution.
Atheism - America's fastest growing belief system.
Promotion of Evolution Theory - Evolutionists aggressively promote their beliefs through the media, Internet, museums, and institutions of higher learning.

- ▶ 45% of Americans believe in biblical creation, yet have little choice but to send their children to public schools teaching evolution as the source of origins.

To justify their silence they often infer that it's okay to accept evolution as long as you believe in salvation through Jesus Christ. They don't seem to grasp how difficult it is to accept the truth of Jesus Christ without the foundational belief in the truth of the Bible.
